AT ITS MEETING, THE STUDENT UNION BOARD MADE THE FOLLOWING DECISIONS:

- The board will confirm the agenda of the meeting after adding a new item “8. TaiYo’s grants for projects, associations and committees, application period of the autumn”. (Appendix 4)
- The Board decided to take note of the discussion on the financial situation. The Board decided they will not get paid for their board work for the month of December to balance the financial situation.
- The Board decided to sign the advocacy paper related to the development of inclusivity in student information systems and student registers.
- The Board decided to propose Artturi Vuorinen as TaiYo’s candidate for the Board of the National Union of University Students in Finland for 2025.
- The Board decided to change the annual decision on grants according to the proposal so that the deadline for applications is 7 October.
- The Board decided to take note of the following:
 - 11.9. Secretary General Kärnä and Coordinator of the Free Arts Space Korvuo met with representatives of the City of Helsinki’s Kallion kesäkadut project with the University’s Head of Communications and Public Affairs about a possible partnership.
 - 12.9., Chairperson Koironen and Secretary General Kärnä attended the Rector’s lunch celebrating the alumni of the year.
 - 12.9. Opening of the academic year of the university. Chairperson Koironen gave a speech representing the Student Union, board member Kujansuu was one of the hosts of the event, and board member Huilla’s works were on display in the Bachelor’s exhibition at Kuva/Tila gallery, which opened on the day of the opening.
 - 13.9. Chairperson Koironen, Vice-Chair Vuorinen and Secretary General Kärnä met Dean of the Sibelius Academy Emilie Gardberg about promoting appropriate and equal treatment and how dialogue between students, staff and management could be enabled and students’ voices could be heard and heard better than before.
