Project grants

Rationale

- The allocation of the grants is based on the Board's decision from its meeting 3/2022 ([linkki](#)).
- Project 2 and project 3 entail artistic work but both have community as a central characteristic of the project. The art is a platform for coming together. That is why these projects were considered eligible for the project grant.
- In the comparison between applications, project 1 and 4 got the highest score, thus they were allocated the full amount they applied for.

Association grants

Rationale

- Kukko ry sent the application by the deadline, but not the required appendices. After request, the appendices (budget, financial statements, action plan) were delivered on Monday 20 October.
- The students of cultural study of music dissolved their association, Kumulaatio ry, in the spring as they were graduating. The new students then decided to establish the association anew. The association had not yet been established when the application was sent. Kumulaatio ry was allocated an association grant of 90€ in the spring. The association gifted the remaining 48,75 € of their money to TaiYo once they dissolved. The Board decided that the new Kumulaatio will be allocated a 10€ grant from the association grants budget and will be returned the 48,75€ euros previously gifted to TaiYo. Kumulaatio sent their memorandum of association, action plan and rules on Tuesday 21 October. It was considered that the new Kumulaatio is in a clear enough way continuing the work and activities of the old Kumulaatio that the new Kumulaatio is entitled to the association grants that are reserved to associations operating within TaiYo.
- Sakko ry sent in all the required documents on time and thus the Board decided to allocate the most significant amount of the grants to them.

Committee grants

Siba United has been previously granted their committee grant, so Kuva and Teak committees' grants remain. Teak committee sent an application outside of the application period but this has no real effect when it comes to committees' grants.
