IN ITS MEETING THE BOARD OF THE STUDENT UNION MADE THE FOLLOWING DECISIONS:

- The board confirmed the agenda of the meeting, after moving the item 'The board's regular meeting time in the fall' as the new number 5 and renumbering the rest of the item. (Appendix 4)
- The board decided that the regular board meetings will take place on Thursdays at 12:00 PM alternating between the Student Room in N-building and Kookos building in Sörnäinen, unless using the Kookos meeting rooms during the day becomes an issue. Separate calls for meetings will be sent only about extraordinary meetings. The goal is that the meetings will be a maximum of three hours. After 1,5 hours there will be a break. The meetings will be held in English, but board members may also use Finnish.

Matters intended to be on the agenda of the meeting must be submitted to the chair or secretary general for regular meetings by Monday at noon and for other meetings in accordance with the instructions given by the chair and secretary general. Absences from meetings must be reported to the chair or secretary general as soon as possible and, if possible, no later than the day before the meeting.

- The Board decided to approve the joint open letter with Uniarts students for Palestine to be sent to the University of Arts Helsinki Board and gave the mandate to secretary general Kärnä and chairperson Aaltio to finalize the letter with the representatives of the Uniarts student for Palestine.
- The Board decided to name Jaakko Pennanen as the student representative to the recruitment group for the substitute lecturer in painting.
- The Board decided name the student representative to the IN.TUNE university alliance according to the appendix.
- The Board decided to name Hanneriina Moisseinen as the doctoral researcher representative to the Division for doctoral education in the Academy of Fine Arts.
- The Board decided to approve TaiYo's election programme for the 2027 parliamentary elections and give the mandate to the secretary general to finalize it.
- The Board decided that secretary general Jane Kärnä will represent the student union at the World Student Capital spring meeting on June 9.
- The Board decided to take note of the discussion about visiting the potential new Vapaan taiteen tila.
- The Board decided to take note of the discussion on current topics from each sector.
